Notes for employers

What is the AEC (Additional Employer Contribution)?

The AEC contribution is an employer funded superannuation contribution that SASS, SSS and PSS employers must pay each month for employees who are eligible for the contribution. Contributions are payable at the rate of 1.0% of the member's superable salary.

What determines whether a member is eligible?

Only members whose remuneration is subject to the NSW Government Wages Policy are eligible for this contribution.

How can I check the current status of a member?

You can check the current status of a member through the **Member Administration** section of the **STC Employer Portal**.
